The Mathematical Society of the Philippines (MSP) invites you to participate in its Summer Upgrading Program for College Mathematics Teachers (SUPCOM) on 20-21 May 2015 at the MMSU Hostel, Mariano Marcos State University, City of Batac, Ilocos Norte. SUPCOM is a 2-day seminar-workshop which aims to help teachers of college-level mathematics enhance their knowledge, sharpen their mathematical skills, and hone their teaching techniques. It is also open to mathematics teachers of high schools with special science and mathematics curricula. The topics for SUPCOM 2015 will be

- (1) Mathematics in the Modern World: a Course in the New GE Curriculum of CHED,
- (2) Efficient Strategies in Teaching College Mathematics, and
- (3) Mathematical Modeling.

The registration fee is Php 2,000 and will cover lunch and workshop materials. Instructions for registration and payment of registration fee are in the attached forms. The deadline for registration is **4 May 2015**. The number of available slots for the seminar-workshop is limited and will be given on a first-come-first-served basis.
